#### BookLamp.org <sup>[4]</sup>

BookLamp.org is intended to help you find new books by comparing the content of the books themselves, similar to the way that [Pandora.com](#) <sup>[5]</sup> matches music lovers to new music. We're attempting to help you find books with similar themes and writing style to books you've enjoyed in the past.

Goodreads is a social network for readers. It is free to join. Members recommend books, compare what they are reading, keep track of what they've read and would like to read, form book clubs and much more.

#### The Internet Movie Database <sup>[8]</sup>

IMDB is a comprehensive online database devoted to film and television. Use it to find plot summaries, memorable quotes, awards, reviews, box office performance, filming locations, trivia, and links to official and other websites. You can also learn about titles in production, including major announced projects still in development. IMDB is your source for filmographies which include biographical details, awards listings, external links, and information about other professional work. IMDB also offers ancillary material such as daily movie and TV news, weekly box office reports, TV listings, cinema showtimes, user polls and ratings, and special features about various movie events such as the Academy Awards.

### The Billboard Top 100 [9]

The Billboard Top 100 music chart lets you discover the latest top 100 hits, while keeping tabs on your favorite artists.

### Pandora.com [5]

With Pandora you can explore this vast trove of music to your heart's content. Just drop the name of one of your favorite songs, artists or genres into Pandora and let the Music Genome Project go.
